



Memorial Gardens

Available at Gungahlin and Hall Cemeteries a Memorial Garden allotment is an ashes grave, with memorialisation by way of a plaque installed on the border of the Memorial Garden.

The interment of ashes is included in the allotment cost. In accordance with Canberra Memorial Parks policy, only one set of ashes can be interred in a Memorial Garden allotment. The memorial plaque is not included in the cost of the allotment.

Interments can take place seven days of the week however additional fees may apply on the weekend.

Only fresh flowers are permitted to be placed at the grave.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items at the memorial.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I make my own plantings in the garden bed?

No. The Canberra Memorial Parks caretakers oversee plantings and landscaping within the grounds, to ensure aesthetic and environmental appeal is maintained. Individual plantings by families are not permitted and will be removed. You may leave fresh flowers at a memorial.

Can more than one set of ashes be interred?

No. Only one set of ashes can be interred per allotment.

Can we inter ashes without an urn?

Yes. It is possible to inter the ashes without an urn, but you cannot scatter ashes on the Memorial Garden bed.

Can I select my own urn?

Yes. It is possible to choose your own urn but selections should be made with consideration to space limitations.
