



Memorial Rock

Available at Gungahlin and Woden Cemeteries, a Memorial Rock allotment is an ashes grave, with memorialisation by way of a plaque installed on a rock, which is positioned in a garden bed.

Standard Memorial Rocks have provision for two sets of ashes and two memorial plaques.

The first interment is included in the cost of the allotment. Subsequent interments will incur additional fees.

Plaques are not included in this cost and are paid for at the time of need.

Interments can take place seven days of the week however additional fees may apply on the weekend.

Only Fresh flowers are permitted at the grave.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items at the memorial.



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Frequently Asked Questions

Can I make my own plantings in a Memorial Rock Garden?

No. The Canberra Memorial Parks caretakers oversee plantings and landscaping within the grounds, to ensure aesthetic and environmental appeal is maintained. Individual plantings by families are not permitted and will be removed. You may leave fresh flowers at a memorial.

Can I install an additional plaque?

No. To protect the design integrity of the area only two plaques are allowed on each rock.

Can I get a bigger plaque?

No. The design integrity of the site prohibits different plaque sizes to protect the overall appeal of the memorial rock beds.

Can I inter more ashes at the rock?

No. To retain design integrity and manage space limitations, a maximum of two sets of ashes can be interred at each rock.
