



# Monumental Lawn

Available at Gungahlin Cemetery, a Monumental Lawn allotment is a lawn grave, with memorialisation by way of a small headstone on the concrete beam at the head of the grave.

Graves are prepared to double depth. Most graves can be prepared to triple depth, which incurs an additional fee.

A headstone is not included in the cost of the allotment. Documentation will be issued post-burial and will include a list of local stonemasons who can arrange headstone construction.

A permit is required for the construction of the headstone and a permit fee will apply.

Cleaning and maintenance of the monument is the responsibility of the family. Canberra Memorial Parks is responsible for the maintenance of the cemetery grounds only.

In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.

Only fresh flowers are permitted at the Grave. Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items at the memorial.



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# Frequently Asked Questions

## **How long do I have to construct the headstone?**

Headstones must be constructed within two years of the date of the burial.

## **Do I have to have a headstone?**

You can have a plaque in place of a headstone. Canberra Memorial Parks has a range that you can choose from.

## **Can I choose my own stonemason?**

Yes, however, they must be approved by Canberra Memorial Parks. A permit for construction must be submitted to Canberra Memorial Parks prior to commencement of construction.
