



Family Estate

Available at Gungahlin Cemetery, a Family Estate is comprised of a garden bed with a tree planted in the centre. The garden is bordered by four concrete beams forming a square. There are eight lawn graves in total around the outer edge of the square, and they are purchased in pairs.

Family Estate allotments for interment of ashes are also available.

Interments can take place seven days of the week. Graves are prepared to double depth. Most graves can be prepared to triple depth, which incurs an additional fee.

Memorialisation is by way of a small headstone or plaque installed on the concrete beam at the head of the grave. These are not included in the cost of the allotment.

Documentation will be issued post-burial and will include a list of local stonemasons who can arrange headstone construction.

A plaque may be installed instead of a headstone. In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.



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Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to have a headstone?

No. You can choose to have a plaque installed and you should consult Canberra Memorial Parks. Additional fees will apply.

Can I inter cremated remains in a burial allotment.

It is possible to inter cremated remains in a burial allotment, however, it is dependent on the burials in place already. Please contact Canberra Memorial Parks to discuss the options for a specific allotment.

Can I have more than one burial in an allotment?

Yes. Each allotment can hold up to three burials. The number of burials must be decided at the time of the first burial, to ensure the allotment is prepared accordingly.
