



Niche Repose

Available at the Sanctuary Creek memorial garden in the grounds of Gungahlin Cemetery.

The Niche Repose memorial is a tradition interment option in a yellow granite allotment. It frames garden beds throughout Sanctuary Creek.

A memorial plaque is used to seal the interment space. Due to this, the plaque must be installed at the same time as interment.

We may be able to offer additional companion allotments, depending on availability.

Interments can take place 7 days a week. You can also choose to hold a service or gathering may be held in the Sanctuary Creek memorial garden at the time of interment.



Plantings and flowers

The horticulturalists at Canberra Memorial Parks are responsible for maintenance, landscaping and plantings. Individual plantings by families are not permitted and will be removed. However, you are welcome to leave fresh flowers at the memorial.

Keepsakes and trinkets

The Niche Repose is designed specifically for the interment of cremated remains only. Other memorial options within Sanctuary Creek may allow the interment of keepsakes and trinkets, depending on your requirements. Please ask us about other memorial options if you wish to inter keepsakes or trinkets with your loved one.

Reserving an allotment

You can reserve a Niche Repose allotment. Payment for allotments must be received in full. You do not need to pay the plaque fees to reserve an allotment.

Choosing a plaque

A bronze plaque is available for Niche Repose interments.

You can arrange and pay for the plaque at a later time. Please feel free to take time to choose your desired wording and plaque design.


However, the plaque must be installed at the same time as the interment.
