



Tree Allotment

Available at Gungahlin and Woden Cemeteries, a tree allotment is an ashes grave, with memorialisation by way of large plaque installed on a granite block. The block is positioned at the base of the tree and inset into the ground.

Tree allotments have two purchase options. A tree can be purchased as an individual tree or shared tree. The individual tree option has provision for a family to have up to six ashes interments and plaques, with the first being included in the cost of the allotment. The shared tree allotment is for one ashes interment and one plaque on a granite block.

Interments can take place seven days of the week however additional fees may apply on the weekend.

Only Fresh flowers are permitted at the grave.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items at the memorial.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I make my own plantings around the tree?

No. The maintenance, landscaping and plantings are the responsibility of the horticulturalists here at Canberra Memorial Parks. Individual plantings by families are not permitted and will be removed. You may leave fresh flowers at a memorial.

Can I install an additional plaque?

No. Only one plaque per allotment is permitted.

Can I inter more than one set of ashes?

No. Only one set of ashes can be interred in a designated allotment under a tree.

Can I choose a location at a shared tree?

Depending on availability, it may be possible to choose your preferred location.
