



Lawn Allotment

Available at Woden Cemetery, a lawn allotment is a lawn grave with memorialisation by way of a chrome or bronze plaque installed on a raised concrete block at the head of the grave.

Interments can take place seven days of the week. Graves are prepared to double depth, but most graves can be prepared to triple depth, which incurs an additional fee.

Plaques and concrete blocks are not included in the price and are available for an additional fee.

In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.

Although fresh flowers are permitted at the grave, Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items on the site.



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Frequently Asked Questions

Is the plaque included in the price?

No. Plaques must be purchased separately.

Can I have my own headstone built?

No. To maintain the appearance of the cemetery, only the approved plaques can be used as memorialisation.

Can I choose my own plaque?

The type of plaque must be consistent with Canberra Memorial Parks specifications, but you may design the plaque to your liking.

Can I have a dedication seat at the grave?

Yes. If space permits a dedication seat may be installed adjacent to your chosen allotment or at another point in the cemetery. Additional fees will apply.
