



Vault Allotment

Available at Gungahlin and Woden Cemeteries, a vault allotment is a headstone grave that has a sealed, double-depth, concrete crypt installed within the allotment. The memorialisation is by way of a full monument covering the entire length of the grave.

Pre-installed vaults can be purchased. Alternatively, subject to site approval by Canberra Memorial Parks, a vault can be installed in your preferred position, which incurs an additional fee.

Interments can take seven days of the week.

A monument is not included in the allotment fees. A list of stonemasons is available from Canberra Memorial Parks.

Cleaning and maintenance of the monument is the responsibility of the family. Canberra Memorial Parks is responsible for the maintenance of the cemetery grounds only.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable or sentimental items on the site.



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Frequently Asked Questions

Does the deceased have to be embalmed?

Yes. Under health regulations all crypt burials require the body to be embalmed.

Can I have more than two burials in a vault allotment?

No. The design of the vault prohibits more than two burials per vault allotment.

Do I need a special coffin?

You must either have a zinc lined coffin or the body must be in a bio-seal bag which may impact on the opportunity to have an open coffin at the funeral.

Can a vault be reponed once it has been sealed?

Yes. Fees for reopening of vaults are provided below.
