



Liquidambar Lane

Available at Woden Cemetery, Liquidambar Lane is comprised of a series of polished granite beams set beneath majestic liquidambar trees. Each granite beam houses a number of individual ashes receptacles. Each receptacle is sealed with a bronze memorial plaque.

Only one set of ashes can be interred in each Liquidambar Lane allotment and the memorial plaque must be made prior to the interment as it is used to seal the receptacle.

Interments can take place Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.00am and 3.00pm.

Only fresh flowers can be placed at the site.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items on the site.



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Frequently Asked Questions

How long does it take to organise an interment?

Canberra Memorial Parks requires up to ten working days' notice to organise an interment.

Can we make our own plaque?

No. To ensure the design integrity of the site Liquidambar Lane plaques must be consistent with other plaques in the area.

Can you place any keepsakes in with the ashes when you inter them?

Space in the receptacles is quite limited, and Canberra Memorial Parks cannot guarantee keepsakes will fit in the interment space.
