



Olive Grove

Available at Gungahlin Cemetery, Olive Grove offers an elegant alternative to the traditional burial allotment.

Featuring a beam of olive trees set in a raised garden bed bounded by granite, Olive Grove offers burials in a lawn area with memorialisation by way of a plaque set in the garden bed.

Providing a tranquil resting place, Olive Grove's appeal will only enhance with time.

Interments can take place seven days of the week. Graves are prepared to double depth. Most graves can be prepared to triple depth which incurs an additional fee.

In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.

Only fresh flowers are permitted to be placed at interment sites in Olive Grove.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items on the site.



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Frequently Asked Questions

Can we choose our own plaque?

No. The plaque selection is fixed to maintain the design integrity of Olive Grove.

How long do we have to do the plaque?

Canberra Memorial Parks encourages the installation of plaques within two years of interment.

Can we plant anything in the garden bed?

No. The Canberra Memorial Parks caretakers oversee plantings and landscaping within the grounds, to ensure aesthetic and environmental appeal is maintained.
