



Ashes Interments

Interment of cremated remains (ashes) is available at all Canberra Memorial Parks cemeteries. They may be placed in a specific memorial allotment or can be interred into an existing earth grave with other family members who may already be buried.

Interment of ashes can take place seven days a week. A staff member may be available to assist with placement of ashes for bookings between 9am and 3pm on weekdays if required. If the

family does not wish to be present; staff will inter the ashes and notify the family once complete. Weekend and after-hours interments can be arranged, subject to certain conditions.

A copy of the Cremation Certificate must accompany the Application for Interment and, although two sets of ashes may be interred at the same time, only one container per deceased person is permitted.

The placement of personal, valuable, or sentimental items is discouraged.

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Frequently Asked Questions

Can I bury ashes at Canberra Memorial Parks if the cremation took place somewhere else.

Yes. All we require is a copy of the cremation certificate from the facility where the deceased was cremated. Once we have this, and an interment location has been purchased, the ashes can be interred.

Can I choose my own urn?

Yes. Canberra Memorial Parks can assist you with selecting and purchasing a new urn. The dimensions of your chosen urn will need to be provided to Canberra Memorial Parks, to ensure the interment space is prepared accordingly.

Can I have multiple urns?

Yes. It is possible to split ashes into multiple urns. Fees apply for additional urns and transfer of ashes.

Can I have a graveside service for an ashes interment?

Yes. You are welcome to hold a graveside service at time of interment. This can be conducted with, or without, Canberra Memorial Parks staff present.
